Day 1: Arrive Bulawayo - Matobo Pillars

Fly into Bulawayo today where you will meet your private guide and be transferred to Matobo to meet your private chef and team. Enjoy your first night camping where we will be delighted with chef meals around the campfire, introductions, a tour briefing and plans for the next day.

Day 2: Explore Matobo

Today we will enjoy a game drive with Big Cave Camp and a rhino walking experience. Our chef will cook up a storm back at our camp for breakfast, lunch and dinner and in the afternoon we can take a hike to one of the many cave painting areas to see why this area both historically and conservation wise is so special.

Day 3: Matobo to Harare

We will pack up camp after a nice breakfast and make our way across Zimbabwe to the bustling city of Harare where we will overnight in a roadside lodge on dinner, bed and breakfast. Enjoy a picnic lunch en-route with your guide team.

Day 4: Harare to Chinhoyi Caves

After breakfast we make our way up to Chinhoyi Caves. Explore the caves this afternoon and then relax in a nearby lodge on dinner, bed and breakfast.

Day 5: Chinhoyi Caves to Mana Pools

We make the winding and a little bumpy route up to Mana Pools this morning. Stop for a picnic lunch and then we set up camp and rest after the journey.

Day 6&7: Explore Mana Pools

Enjoy a full day in Mana Pools, here we slow right down and enjoy the nature around us, we will get a guide for walking safaris in the area as your team prepares delicious meals in the wilderness.

Day 8: Mana Pools to Karoi

We head out of Mana Pools today and find ourselves in the tiny town of Karoi for a quick overnight on dinner, bed and breakfast.



Day 9: Karoi to Matusadona

It's a dirt road journey today as we skirt the edges of Kariba and into the heart of Matusadona National Park. Drop into the escarpment and we settle ourselves in Tashinga Campsite. Rest this afternoon after the journey and explore the camp.

Day 10&11: Explore Matusadona

Today you have many choices, we can head out on a game drive, go tiger fishing, head out on a boat cruise or game walk... the choice is yours. We've included one major activity a day but more activities can be booked and paid for direct during our stay.

Day 12: Matusadona to Hwange National Park

It's an early morning departure and one of our longest driving routes today as we head to Hwange on a... challenging road! But that's part of the fun. Your chef team will look after you and we set up camp in Robins Camp in Hwange for a restful night.

Day 13 & 14: Explore Hwange National Park

This morning self explore at your leisure after the journey the previous day. Enjoy game drives with your Land and Lake Guide. Relax and enjoy the sounds of the wilderness.

Day 15: Hwange National park to Victoria Falls

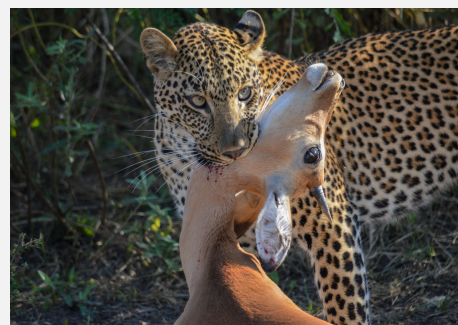
