



10D Northern Circuit Malawi Classic

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Included: Transport (door to door, water, private vehicle & English speaking driver) All meals and activities indicated apart from Makzuzi Beach Lodge in Chintheche. Taxes, fuel and levies, non motorized watersport activities, game park entrance fees.

Excluded: Flights, Visas, any meals not indicated below, drinks unless specified, activities not indicated, motorized water sports, scuba diving, spa treatments or personal spending or gratuities.

Day 1: Lilongwe to Dzalanyama Forest

Depart no later than 3pm from Lilongwe and drive to the Miombo Woodlands of Dzalanyama Forest on the border of Malawi and Mozambique. Night here including all your meals, bike hire, walking and exploring. Relax today in the woodlands, take advantage of river swimming and trails.

Day 2: Explore Dzalanyama

Be as busy or slow as you choose, hit the trails, go and visit the big waterfall and take a picnic lunch with you, explore by bike or if you'd like to a taste of Malawi Village life, head into the nearby Kachere Village for a tour with your guide. Taste local food, brew and learn about traditional villages in an unstaged exploration. Night in Dzalanyama including all your meals and activities.

Day 3: Dzalanyama to Viphya Plateau

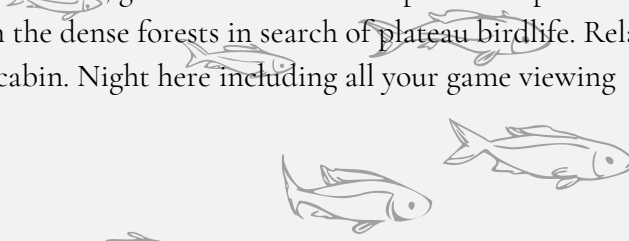
Depart no later than midday as we head north of Malawi, take a picnic lunch with and drive up to the rolling hills of Viphya, night at Luwawa Forest Lodge where if you're on a birding journey ties in perfectly to your exploration around Dzalanyama. Stay with Luwawa on dinner, bed and breakfast.

Day 4: Viphya Plateau to Nyika Plateau

We continue the journey northwards, through the bustling city of Mzuzu - Stop to pick up some snacks and lunch for the journey to Nyika. We enter the gates and take a winding game drive to the lodge overlooking the rolling hills beyond. Included in your stay is all your game viewing activities and meals as well as your game park entrance fees.

Day 5 & 6: Explore Nyika Plateau

Nyika is a unique game viewing destination in Africa seldom found in other regions. Enjoy fly fishing in the dams, game drives to find leopards and plains game or hyena, walk through the dense forests in search of plateau birdlife. Relax by a roaring fire in your log cabin. Night here including all your game viewing activities and meals.



Day 7: Nyika Plateau to Chitheche Beach

Depart after breakfast and we make our way down the plateau, back through Mzuzu and on to the crystal white shores of Northern Lake Malawi. Arrive mid afternoon after stopping for lunch. Night at Makuzi Beach on room only - Meals and additional activities can be booked directly with your accommodation.

Day 8: Chitheche to Nankoma Island

We head off in the morning and make our way down the lakeshore road to the boat pick-up point in Senga Bay. Jump on the boat and we head to Nankoma Island in time for lunch. Spend the rest of the afternoon exploring the island. Included here are all your meals, park entrance fees and non motorized watersport activities.

Day 9: On Nankoma Island

Enjoy a full day on Nankoma Island with Blue Zebra Island Lodge including all your meals and all non-motorized watersports. There are hiking trails and kayaks available and additional activities that can be booked and paid for such as spa treatments and motorized watersports.

Day 10: End

Head back to Lilongwe and we say goodbye, no accommodation has been booked tonight and if you have an international flight out - departure from the island must allow a 3hour transfer (Ensure you book your flight departure for an afternoon flight)
