



14D Best of Wildlife Zambia Classic

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Included: Transport (door to door, water, private vehicle & English speaking driver including back-up vehicle and private chef) All meals and activities indicated. Nylon tents, sleeping cots, zinch Mattress, bedding, towels. Taxes, fuel and levies, non motorized watersport activities, game park entrance fees.

Excluded: Flights, Visas, any meals not indicated below, drinks unless specified, activities not indicated, motorized water sports, scuba diving, spa treatments or personal spending or gratuities.

Day 1: Arrive in Mfuwe

Arrive in Mfuwe today where you'll be met by our guide at the airport and transferred to Zikomo Safari Camp where you'll meet your private chef team. Enjoy your first night camping on the edge of the Luangwa River in Nsefu.

Day 2: Nsefu to Luambe

After an early breakfast, we take a slow game drive route through Nsefu to Luambe National Park. Enjoy a night in the self-catering Luambe Camp where your private chef will organise your meals.

Day 3: Luambe to North Luangwa

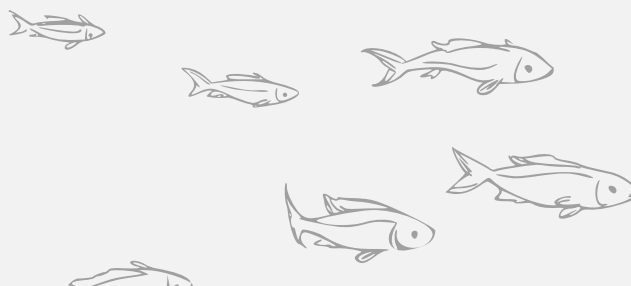
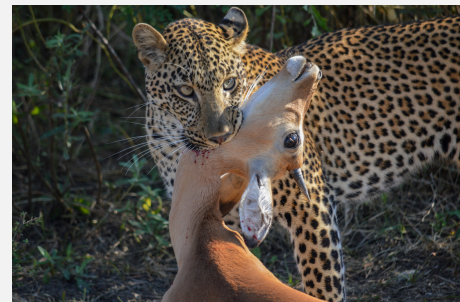
Your back-up team will collapse camp while you take a slow game drive up through Luambe and into North Luangwa. Settle yourself into camp after exploring the wilderness of North Luangwa with your Land and Lake Guide.

Day 4: Explore North Luangwa

A typical day on safari is an early start with a light breakfast before heading out and looking for the wildlife that calls North Luangwa Home. Return to your campsite where your private chef will have a brunch prepared. Relax in the early afternoon before setting off again to return to the camp for dinner.

Day 5: North Luangwa to Kapishya Hot Springs

We collapse camp today and make our way up the escarpment to Kapishya Hot Springs. Get your swimming costumes on and enjoy the steaming pools before settling yourself into your lodge accommodation including dinner, bed and breakfast.



Day 6: Kapishya Hot Springs to Bangweulu Wetlands

Take a slow drive through remote villages today and onto the open plains of Bangweulu. Here we will set up camp and your chef prepares dinner under the stars.

Day 7: Explore Bangweulu Wetlands

We've organised a shoebill walk this morning in search of this incredible and elusive species - after a campsite brunch, head out for an afternoon game drive to discover this sprawling wild scenery. Night camping in the open plains.

Day 8: Bangweulu Wetlands to Kasanka National Park

Break Camp and we make our way to Kasanka - Stop at David Livingstones Memorial en-route and then we set-up camp on the edge of a reeded riverbed that's popular with the shy Sitatunga. Camp tonight as your chef prepares your meals.

Day 9: Explore Kasanka

Enjoy a morning walk to explore this quiet and remote park, relax in the afternoon back at camp before heading out in the evening for a game drive - October and November Kasanka fills with the fruit bat migration!

Day 10: Kasanka to Mutinondo Wilderness

We make a winding journey to the escarpment overlooking the Luangwa Valley. Its our last night of camping and the last night with your private chef team. Enjoy this peaceful woodland fills with incredible birdlife.

Day 11: Mutinondo Wilderness to South Luangwa National Park

An adventurous journey as we make our way down the escarpment and into the Valley of the Leopard! Arrive in Nkozi Camp, located in the heart of the Luangwa Valley. Enjoy a special treat in this remote camp including tented chalet accommodation and all your meals and activities with Nkozi Camp and Gavin Opie.

Day 12 & 13: Explore South Luangwa National Park

Your Land and Lake Guide and Team have said their farewells and left you in the capable hands of Gavin Opie and the Nkonzi Team as you enjoy walking safaris and game drives in this stunning and quiet section of South Luangwa National Park that is teeming with wildlife. Spend your days and nights here including all your meals, game viewing activities and game park entrance fees.

Day 14: End

Nkonzi Camp will transfer you through the park to the airport in time for your flight out of Mfuwe. End of the adventure!
